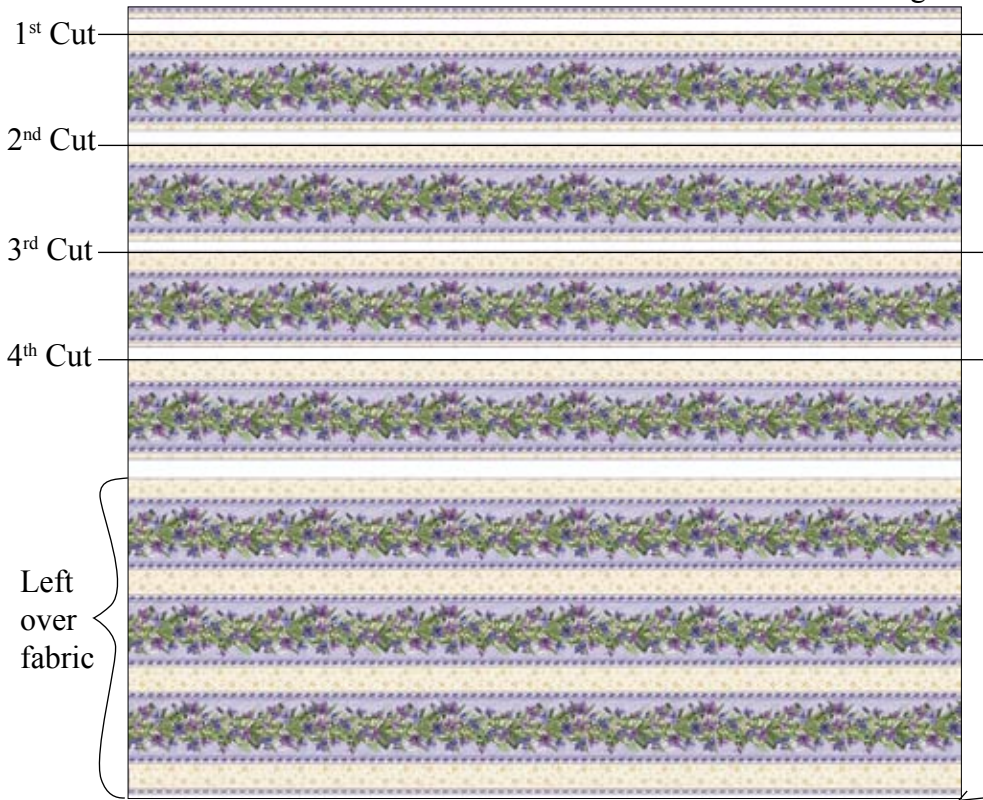


Violet Handkerchiefs Stripe Cutting Tips

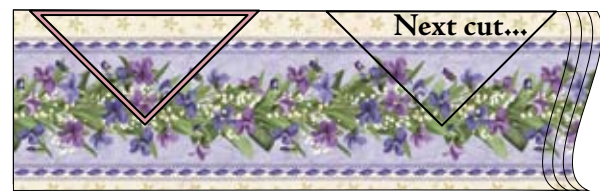
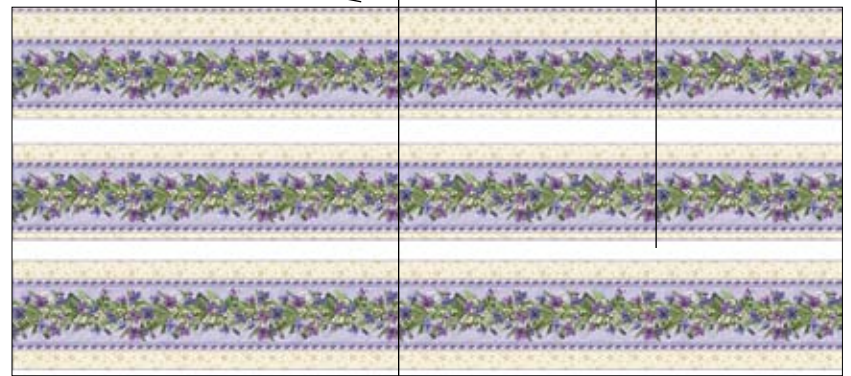
STRIPE CUTTING TIP (8" repeat in the stripe design): Cut the first four repeats starting from one end of the fabric width (selvage 1). For the remaining blocks and to add variety in your finished blocks cut the remaining repeats from the other end of the left over fabric (selvage 2).



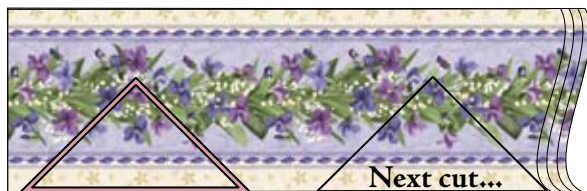
BTW,
If you have cut all of the stripes from one end (selvage 1) that's OK too! Just pile and cut as many variations as you can for variety in your finished quilt.

Selvage 2 ~ Remaining fabric has been rotated 180° before cutting.

There will be 3 remaining strips so rotate the leftover fabric 180° and the remaining strips from selvage 2 side of yardage. Cut one of the strips in half to get a short pile of 4 repeats. There will now be two short strips left. Cut those in 1/2 and try for one last block.



Cut first four repeats from one side of the stripe.



Cut the remaining fabric from the other side (selvage 2).



Make 9 different handkerchief blocks.

Measure 6-1/2" square unfinished.
